Karen joined Faiss Foley Warren in December 2013 and brings 15 years of journalism and strategic communications experience to the team. She leads the FFW team on the Coalition to Defeat the Margin Tax Initiative and serves as the coalition’s spokesperson.

As a former anchor and political reporter at several television stations, Karen has covered some of the most-watched political races in the country, including the 2010 Senate race between Majority Leader Harry Reid and Sharron Angle. She has her finger firmly on the pulse of current and public affairs across Nevada.

Karen is originally from central California and has a B.A. in Journalism from the University of Nevada, Reno. Karen is a former board member of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences and served as Vice President of Soroptimist International of Reno. Karen and her husband, Matt, are the parents of two young children.

Congressman, Dr. Joe Heck



On November 2, 2010, Joe Heck was elected to the United States Congress as Nevada’s Representative for the Third Congressional District.

Heck is only the third person to hold this seat since its creation. He was the only freshman appointed to serve on the House Permanent Committee on Intelligence, and chairs the Subcommittee on Technical and Tactical Intelligence.

Dr. Heck has more than 25 years in public service as a physician, Army Reservist, and community volunteer. A Colonel in the U.S. Army Reserves, he was called to active duty three times, including a deployment to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Dr. Heck represented Nevada State Senate District 5 from 2004 through 2008, serving on the Natural Resources, Human Resources and Education, and the Commerce and Labor Committees, and as Vice-Chair of the Transportation and Homeland Security Committee.
