

# Boston's proposed Green Ordinance could have you seeing **RED.**

The City of Boston is considering passing a proposed energy ordinance that could result in widespread rent increases throughout the city.

Costs forced upon building owners by the City will ultimately be paid through **rent increases** required of **residential and commercial** tenants, who already pay for energy saving and conservation measures in their utility bills. Paying these costs twice will place an unfair burden on renters.

The Greater Boston Real Estate Board supports policies and programs aimed at conserving energy and protecting our environment.

**We need environmental education and programs that reward landlords for smart energy use. Not an ordinance that punishes tenants.**
