Do the BOMA Standards offer any guidelines with respect to occupant density?

Introduction The Floor Measurement Standards Committee of BOMA International has approved this Best Practice to provide clarification and guidance with respect to the BOMA Standard(s) disclosed herein. This Best Practice does not modify any of the BOMA publications but may be considered for inclusion in future updates.

Question: *Do the BOMA Standards offer any guidelines with respect to occupant density?*

Answer: The BOMA measurement standards do not consider nor do they offer any guidelines with respect to occupant density. Density plays no role at all when calculating building measurements. Such guidelines can be found in local building codes.
